Over the summer holidays we have devised a Kelmscott reading challenge which is compulsory for all year 7 and year 8 students.

You will need to read 600 pages from a variety of different reading books of your choice (they can be in any language). When you have finished reading each book please complete the table.

The aim of this challenge is to continue the good reading practices you have built up during school term time. Research shows periods of absence from learning at school can result in students reading ages decreasing.

Research by The National Literacy Trust showed that students who read daily outside school are five times more likely to read above the expected level for their age compared to students who never read outside class.
