
Book Review: Shadowhunters

K-Pop

What is k-pop?

Kpop is KOREAN POP MUSIC.

Although it generally classifies "popular music" within South Korea, the term is often used in a narrower sense to describe a modern form of South Korean pop that is influenced by styles and genres from around the world.

Modern K-pop "idol" culture began with the boy band H.O.T. in 1996, as K-pop grew into a subculture that amassed enormous fandoms of teenagers and young adults.

Koreans or Asians who want to become idols, go for auditioning in companies such as BigHit, JYP, YG, Cube, Starship Entertainment, SM, Pledis, FNC etc... they train for a couple of years. They learn how to dance, sing, rap etc... Once the judges think they are ready, the auditioners are ready to debut.

Then the CEO of the company puts them into a group or soloists and they start making music (KPOP)

How many K-pop groups are there?

There are many k-pop bands out there but there are nearly **119** active bands, **64** boy groups and **55** girl groups. Some of the most popular k-pop bands are: Super Junior, Big bang, Girls generation, Monsta X, Got7, Infinite, EXO and BTS.

Do you know BTS?

BTS is a Korean boy band who are really popular right now in many countries.

They are also known as the Bangtan boys which means Bulletproof Boy Scouts and Beyond the Scene. "Bangtan" in Korean means "Bulletproof" which is why they are called Bulletproof Boy Scouts.

BTS is a boyband which debuted on June 12th 2013 on Melon Stage in Cheongdamdeong, but their first album "2 Cool 4 Skool" was released the day after that. That's why June 13th 2013 is the official debut date for them.

The main professional wrestling company in the world is the WWE formerly known as the WWF. World Wrestling Entertainment (WWE) is an American media and entertainment that is primarily known for professional wrestling. WWE has also branched out into other fields, including movies, real estate, and various other business ventures.

As of 2018, it is the largest wrestling promotion in the world, holding over 500 events a year, with the roster divided up into various globally traveling brands and is available to about 36 million viewers in more than 150 countries. As in other professional wrestling promotions, WWE shows are not legitimate contests, but purely entertainment-based, featuring storyline-driven, scripted, and choreographed matches, though matches often included moves that can put performers at risk of injury if not performed correctly.

Women in the WWE were not important in the WWE before 2015 and their matches were a maximum of 5 minutes long and were referred to by viewers as 'The bathroom break'. In 2015 fans noticed how the female superstars (formerly divas) were looked at. They started a trend on social media called give divas a chance and the outcome was incredible. In April 2016 at Wrestle-Mania 32, the Divas Championship was retired and subsequently replaced with a new WWE Women's Championship, which has a separate title history from the original. There are many women competing in the WWE, and many who have been inducted into the Hall of fame. Women like Alundra Blayze, Sensational Sherri, Mae Young, The fabulous Moolah, Trish Stratus, Lita and Beth Phoenix along with many more have paved the way for women competing in the industry today.

The Manchester City midfielder scored two goals and set up another in his side's 4-0 win at West Ham United.

Sane has produced attacking returns in all six of his Premier League starts this season and heads up a team who scored a season-high 149 points in a 3-5-2 formation.

GW13 Dream Team

Wayne Hennessey (CRY) £4.5m; 10pts

The Crystal Palace goalkeeper kept his first clean sheet since Gameweek 6 as the Eagles secured a point with a draw at Manchester United.

Trent Alexander-Arnold (LIV) £5.2m; 14pts

All three Dream Team defenders made an impact in attack, with the Liverpool right-back scoring his first goal of the season in the 3-0 win at Watford.

Erik Durm (HUD) £4.4m; 11pts

The full-back scored more than half his points for the campaign as Huddersfield Town won 2-0 at Wolverhampton Wanderers.

Ciaran Clark (NEW) £4.5m; 11pts

Newcastle United's third straight league win came courtesy of Clark's decisive header in Monday night's 2-1 win at Burnley.

Leroy Sane (MCI) £9.3m; 19pts

The winger's ownership has hovered around a quarter of a million for the past three Game weeks. But his star turn at London Stadium has propelled him into the top three for transfers in ahead of a home fixture against AFC Bournemouth.

Aaron Mooy (HUD) £5.1m; 16pts

The Huddersfield Town midfielder had blanked in all 11 of his starts prior to the win at Molineux. Two goals and maximum bonus meant he broke his best for the season by a massive 13 points.

Raheem Sterling (MCI) £11.3m; 16pts

Another day, another huge haul for the Man City midfielder. A goal and two assists against West Ham took Sterling to the top of the FPL standings on 95 points.

Stuart Armstrong (SOT) £5.1m; 14pts

The summer signing from Celtic scored his first two Premier League goals as Southampton went down 3-2 at Fulham.

[Dele Alli \(TOT\) £8.9m; 13pts](#)

Injuries have restricted Alli to only six starts this season. He scored his first goal since Game week 1 and added an assist in Tottenham Hotspur's 3-1 win over Chelsea.

[Aleksandar Mitrovic \(FUL\) £6.6m; 13pts](#)

Three straight blanks sent the Fulham striker's ownership below a million for the first time since Game week 4. The Serb responded with two goals and maximum bonus points in his first match under Claudio Ranieri.

[Roberto Firmino \(LIV\) £9.2m; 12pts](#)

Some 17.3 per cent of Fantasy managers stuck by the Liverpool forward through a seven-Game week barren run. He rewarded them with a goal, an assist and the maximum bonus award in a standout display against Watford.
